

Indirect Tax Update

NBR enables VAT certificate QR code scan functionality

The National Bureau for Revenue (NBR) has launched a new feature enabling businesses to verify a taxpayer's VAT registration status via scanning the QR code displayed on the taxpayer's VAT certificate.

This improved functionality shall then redirect the supplier or customer scanning the QR code to the VAT payer lookup tool made available previously on the NBR's website.

Businesses registered for VAT purposes in Bahrain are urged to regenerate their VAT registration certificate by proceeding to the "My documents" section on their VAT account and using the "Re-print certificate" function.

This update comes as a step forward in the enhancement of the VAT compliance process, in line with the technological advancements taking place in the Kingdom of Bahrain.
